

Bridge to the Future

Our **Bridge to the Future** teamwork activity is perfect for large groups. Sub-teams work together to build a bridge that represents the future goals and aspirations of your organization, and has the structural integrity to support the entire group for team pictures!

There are two amazing aspects of this bridge-building event. Each section will be an independent and artistic representation of the organization's future mission and goals, AND the structure is assembled using only cardboard and duct tape as the principal building materials.

With a focus on project management skills and creative ingenuity, leaders will be chosen and are responsible for ensuring tight deadlines are met. Each team will delegate roles including cardboard cutters, column designers, decorators, and builders.

Team leaders will occasionally be called together for project management meetings to discuss and share strategies, and to cross-share information with other leaders to ensure total success. These meetings are also critical since all of the sub-teams must complete their sections simultaneously to be brought together for the final bridge assembly.

Once the bridge is completed, the entire group will walk onto the bridge to prove its structural integrity and to pose for memorable photos.
